Healthcare Guidelines

Do test yourself for **COVID-19** if you have any symptoms like runny nose, congestion, cough, fever, headache, sore throat, or fatigue.

Do stay home if within **TEN** days prior to **September 2**:

- You show symptoms such as a sore throat, sneezing, runny nose, or fever.
- You, or someone in your home, has tested COVID-19 positive.

Do bring and wear a mask at the campsite in all indoor/populated areas.

Do talk to your doctor if you are **high-risk** for **complications** from COVID-19.

First aid kits and *blood pressure monitors* will be available at multiple locations at the campsite.

If you have **EpiPens**, please bring them, these will not be available at the campsite. Please remember to **bring other medications** that you may need.
